

JOB DESCRIPTION: DOMESTIC CLEANER

Scope & General Purpose:	To perform general cleaning duties (<i>e.g.</i> cleaning, sweeping, vacuum cleaning, emptying of litter bins, polishing and dusting of the fixtures and fittings, pot washing, and to perform other such duties as may be reasonably requested by the Bursar).
Responsible to:	Domestic Team Supervisor.
Hours of work:	<p>1 role – 2.5hrs per day worked early morning (6.00am-8.30am) or early evening (5.30pm-8.00pm), 5 days a week, Monday to Friday, term time only (33 weeks a year).</p> <p>1 role – 6.00am-1.00pm, Saturdays, term time only, when School is in session (approximately 23 Saturdays a year).</p> <p>1 role – 6.30am-2.30pm Monday to Friday, term time only (33 weeks a year)</p> <p>School Term time and at such further times and for such periods as are necessary for the proper performance of your duties.</p>

Overview

The successful candidate will work within a Domestic team of 9 staff and report to the Domestic Team Supervisor. The aim of this team and indeed of all support staff is to work collaboratively to meet the needs of teaching staff and pupils ensuring the better performance of the School.

The successful candidate will be able to contribute to the environment of high standards, good manners, and excellent service at which the School aims.

Key Tasks

To perform general cleaning duties (*e.g.* cleaning, sweeping, vacuum cleaning, emptying of litter bins, polishing and dusting of the fixtures and fittings, pot washing, and to perform other such duties as may be reasonably requested by the Bursar). To relieve and assist other members of domestic staff in certain circumstances. To attend meetings and training courses as requested.

Knowledge, Skills and Experience Required

Essential

- Extremely high level of cleanliness, and a desire to see the highest standards attained.
- Self-motivated with the ability to work under own initiative.
- Physical capability to meet the demands of the role, which will include manual work.
- Positive approach to learning in the role and identifying your own training needs as appropriate; the School would be willing to support learning as required on a mutually agreeable basis.
- A pro-active and flexible approach to role. Hours can occasionally vary depending on the School Calendar, requiring attendance at occasional School events at weekends (*e.g.* annual Speech Day).
- Good time-keeping.
- Enthusiasm, energy and commitment.
- Sense of a humour and a team player.

Desirable

- Experience of cleaning duties while working within a commercial/business setting.
